## Market Day Updates:

- **NO CANDLES, OPEN FLAMES, HEATERS:** Due to fire hazards, open flame candles and heaters (of any kind) are not permitted to be used in your booth.
- **ITEMS LEFT OUTSIDE YOUR BOOTH MAY BE DISCARDED:** When you leave your booth today, be sure there is nothing left around or behind it. Anything that is left outside your booth after the December market day is subject to be thrown away. We will start that clean up project in January 2012 and make a major sweep of the total field, front-back-and sides of all booths will be checked for **remaining debris and it will be discarded.**
- **VENDOR PARKING:** Please remember, unless you have a handicapped sticker on your car, you must remove your car from the field and park in the parking lots. You have a parking pass for these lots and you are expected to use them.
- **DOOR PRIZE DRAWINGS:** Door prize drawings, being held at 11, 12 & 1pm went well the last couple months and we plan to continue the drawings. If you're interested in donating a door prize item, let us know so we can get your information. The winner will be announced, verified and told to go to your booth to pick up their door prize. This will offer one more way for shoppers and vendors to interact.
- If you plan modify your existing space or build a new booth you must have permission IN ADVANCE. Contact Jack Bourke, Field Manager, to get the process started. jbourke@txwinet.com
- It is very IMPORTANT that you contact your Ambassador, in advance, if you are not going to be at Market Day. This will enable the Ambassador to look after your booth should it be day rented to ensure everything is taken care. On the morning of Market Day, you

must call 512-847-2391 before 7 AM if something should come up at the last minute that prevents you from attending.

## Annual Booth Leasing

With the passing of the October 15 deadline, all contracts and checks for the 2012 season should have been turned in.

If you have not turned yours in, you run a very high risk of losing your booth. If your booth is not paid for, it becomes the property of the Lions Club and will be sold to another vendor.

Illness or other unforeseen situations may occur, and if this is the case, you need to come to the leasing booth today and talk to Don Campbell.

The list of booths available for 2012 lease will be released today. Anyone interested in a different or additional booth should see Don at the Annual Leasing booth.

## Please help us enforce our rules:

It is necessary to have rules to have an organized event and, above all, for safety, and some vendors are not obeying the rules of Market Days. Some of the rules that are being broken regularly include:

- **CHECK IN AT ONE OF THE GATES** (even if you arrive the night before). If you are not in your booth by 7am and your booth is rented to a day vendor, you will need to find another booth for that day.
- **NO STORING OF ITEMS OUTSIDE BOOTHS AFTER MARKET DAYS.** Please remove all items from around your booth when you pack up to leave. We will assume any items left are trash and they will be put in the dumpster.
- **NO PERSONAL GOLF CARTS ALLOWED ON THE FIELD.**

The Lions provide golf carts for hauling merchandise and do not permit individuals to bring their own cart onto the field.

- **VENDORS MUST WEAR BADGES WHILE ON THE FIELD.** If you're not wearing your official vendor badge, we have no way of knowing if you are the owner of a booth. We've had trouble with squatters occupying an empty booth without permission and not paying their day booth fee.
- **NO VENDORS ARE TO LEAVE THE FIELD BEFORE 4PM.** Leaving your booth before 4pm is unfair to other vendors as well as creating an unsafe situation for people who are still shopping.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE FIELD.** This is not limited to shoppers, but vendors as well. Please leave dogs at home or in one of our Wimberley kennels during Market Days.
